RE: Support for Plastic Bag Reduction Ordinance in City of San Diego

Dear Surfrider Foundation and Others,

At the March 12, 2014, general membership meeting of the Mission Beach Town Council, Inc., a California non-profit corporation ("MBTC"), a representative from the Surfrider Foundation ("Surfrider") presented its goal of reducing the use of plastic bags, commonly referred to as single-use carry-out plastic bags ("Bags"), by stores and merchants in the City of San Diego.

At the meeting, Surfrider discussed its support for an ordinance in the City of San Diego ("City") enacting a ban on the use of Bags in the City.

Several MBTC members attended the meeting and asked numerous questions as to Surfrider's reasons for supporting a ban, goals of a ban and possible specifics as to the proposed ordinance.

After the presentation and discussion, a motion was made and seconded to vote on the MBTC's support of an ordinance to ban the use of the Bags. Ultimately, a vote was held and a super majority (over 90%) of the voting members approved "**supporting**" an ordinance to prohibit the use of single-use carry-out plastic Bags in the City.
